So, you need to do a research project for class and you want it to be great? Follow these steps to use the library's online resources.

How to Find Ebooks on your Subject

Visit the **SCHS Library** Website

- Bookmarked in your chrome account and searchable through Google!

- ❖ Click on the Research tab on the left-hand side (scroll down to the Rs in alphabetical order) and click on . . .

- ★ Santa Cruz High School Reference Ebooks

- ❖ Gale Virtual Reference Library (65 titles on many subjects) password: santacruzhs

→ Search All (broad) or by Subject (narrow)

The bibliographic information you'll need to cite an ebook source is available on the page! Just scroll to the bottom of the article!

Author's Name(s), title of article in quotation marks, title of book (italicized), edition, volume, name of publisher, year of publication, page(s). URL. Date accessed.

How to Find Databases on your Subject (articles from academic journals, magazines, newspapers, encyclopedias, books and more)

Using the same tabs along the left-hand side, go to . . .

- ★ Research

- ❖ California State Library Resources

- Depending on your subject, try **Britannica**

- **ProQuest eLibrary**, **ProQuest Central Student**, or **SIRS Social Issues Researcher**.
